Best Practice 2019

Communication

This year communication has been done quite early directly by the Best Practice coordinator, with a strong follow up on the website and on social media. The result has been convincing as we have had 20 candidates, to be compared with 10 in 2018, 11 in 2017, 23 in 2016, 25 in 2015, 35 in 2014.

One of the ways to promote the BP process is certainly to publish on the website translations of the tool in other languages than the official ICOM ones. Thanks to the participation from members German, armenian, russian, portuguese and chinese were offered this year.

This is ment to help candidates understanding more deeply the various notions of that complex tool.

A call to produce other national translations could be done next year through the national and regional coordinators.

Results

The jury was organised in Paris May 11th and 12th with Marie-Clarté O'Neill as president, one of last year awardee and one elected board member as jury: Dinara Khalikova (Russia) and Margarita Laraignée (Argentina).

The origin of candidates was extremely diverse this year, the general quality remains good and the evaluation process seems to be mature now after some adjustments.

One can note the relative recurrent weakness of treatment of one point in the tool: Leading the appreciation/evaluation process and forseing a remediation linked to more than professional intuition. This remark may open the way to a specific offer of professional development around appreciation and evaluation methods.
