ICOM Education

ICOM Education 29

The issue 29 of the annual magazine of CECA ICOM Education is dedicated to the theme of education. It was published at the end of 2020, made available online (for free download from the CECA website) and printed in 200 copies in early 2021.

The pandemic had a significant impact on postal connections, which was largely reflected in the mailing of printed copies to authors and committee members. Nevertheless, almost all authors received their copies. In addition, a hundred copies are being sent to universities and cultural mediation training institutions, in order to disseminate the CECA's expertise in this field as widely as possible. In particular, universities and training institutions located in countries with difficulties in accessing information (unstable Internet, for example) and those where the CECA is not yet well established are being sought as a priority. The list of these institutions is being drawn up in order to be able to send them a free copy of ICOM Education 29.

ICOM Education 30

Issue 30 of the journal brings together feature articles on the themes of cultural action (five articles already published in ICOM Education 28) and education (four new articles). Each article is translated into the other two languages in order to have a complete edition of the journal in English, French and Spanish. This issue is currently being prepared for publication in the first half of 2022.

ICOM Education 31

Issue 31 of the journal will be devoted to the theme of Enjoyment / Placer(es) de la visita. The call for papers was published in May 2021, with a submission date of January 2022. The goal is to publish this issue in the summer so that it can be officially presented at the General Conference in Prague 2022.
