Ø Choice of three CECA members to sit on important working groups within ICOM, one (ICWG) to reflect on the future of the International Committees (Marie-Clarté O'Neill), an other to reflect on the functioning of the National Committees and the necessary collaboration with the International Committees (Rosa María Hervás Avilés) and one (ETHCOM) to think about issues related to the professional ethics of museums (Margarita Laraignée).

Ø Calling on the CECA's expertise on hot topical issues: • In Taiwan, on the theme of Co-construction for the inaugural session of the NTCM (New Taipei City Art Museum).

• Also in Taiwan, on the same theme and Best Practice, for a one-day

seminar organized by the Chinese Museum Association. • In Athens, at a conference supported by SAREC on "Museums in Europe: new definition, new perspectives, identity, credibility, sustainability", organised by ICOM Greece, on social sustainability

• In Johanesburg for the UNESCO Regional Office for Southern Africa, as part of a seminar on "Southern African National Liberation Movements Heritage: Museums and Cultural Centres as Places of Learning". The museum's new definition has been broadened considerably, focusing on






