2023 was our second year of experience as CECA coordinator in Africa. It's a year of challenges in terms of the tasks we were responsible for.

### • DEVELOPMENT OF CECA IN AFRICA

The first challenge, which was to extend the CECA in Africa, was almost a success.

First at ICOM Burkina Faso, the number of CECA members has considerably improved by around ten.

Then, at the level of the national committee of Mali with the national correspondent Mamadou Samaké, there were new registered members. In addition, at the level of ICOM Côte d'Ivoire, Charlène Kossonou also registered new members, as well as within ICOM Kenya with the national correspondent Vivian KINOTI.

Furthermore, the number of national correspondents increased by two with the arrival of the national correspondent of Togo Dr Ekoé KUEVIAKOE, Member ICOM TOGO and that of Benin Mister Abdoulaye IMOROU, Curator, Treasurer ICOM Benin.
