

In previous newsletter, we issued a call to consider whether to stick with the acronym CECA or come up with a new one.



CECA annual conference 2024 - Athens

The theme of the next annual conference, to be held in Greece, will be "Delicate topics, challenging audiences". The exact date of the meeting has yet to be announced.

Current projects

- An ambitious training project in French-speaking West Africa has been submitted to SAREC (the ICOM body that funds exceptional projects), with support from national and international committees and UNESCO. We expect to receive a positive response in March.
- The CECA has been asked to co-produce a hybrid seminar in March entitled "Museum Education", proposed by the Research Institute for Cultural Heritage and Tourism in Teheran, Iran.
 Marie-Clarté O'Neill will open the seminar with a lecture on 'The Power of Museum Education', and the coordinators of the SIGs on inclusivity (Raffaella Russo-Ricci) and the development of museum professionals (Wencke Maderbacher) will in turn lead speeches followed by discussions.
- The publication of the volume on the history of museum education in Brazil is underway, thanks to the energy of the authors and Nicole Gesché-Konig, the publishing coordinator. Brazil will be responsible for a paper publication, while the CECA will be responsible for a digital publication in English, Spanish and French.
