ICOM has designed a site template (mini-site) for its committees, based on the structure and visuals of its own website. The webmaster of each mini-site uses this model for the communication of his committee. Each mini-site can be viewed on a PC, browser version, with a drop-down menu on the left.

The browser version with the menu on the left can also be viewed on a mobile phone.

But there's also a mini-site app for mobiles. Designed to maximise the small size of screens, it does away with the menu on the left. Access to the menu and its items is by clicking on the 3 dots at the bottom right of the screen. The CECA site is fully trilingual, and 3 separate menus are available: English, French and Spanish.

Proposals for texts are sent to the President, who is the 'publication director' and who selects them, translates them or has them translated, then sends them to me for integration and illustration. In 2024, the CECA's activities were numerous, and the minisite kept us regularly informed, with details of how to take part in colloquia and competitions, and summaries and reports, very often illustrated with photos or albums.


